Once the Examiner has finished his assessment of the Plan he will write his report which will include a series of recommendations. The overall results can be summarised as follows :

Conservative Party Candidate	10
Rother Association of Independent Councillors	7
Liberal Democrats	7
Labour Party	6
Green Party	3
Independent	3
Labour and Co-Operative Party	2

For us in Peasmarsch, part of the Eastern Rother ward which includes Iden, Playden, Rye Harbour and Camber, there has been no change in councillors with Lizzie Hacking and Paul Osborne both being re-elected.

As you know, there was no election for our Parish Council because only five people, all existing councillors, stood for election.

Having only five councillors leaves the parish council in a precarious position as it may not be able to undertake many of its functions and statutory duties if insufficient councillors are able to attend a council meeting. **Our parish business could ultimately end up being administered by Rother District Council.**

This will be discussed during the Annual Parish Assembly : please consider becoming a councillor.
